WHAT TO EXPECT

AS A RESTORE VOLUNTEER

A volunteer will always start their day signing in on the tablet at the front desk. If this is a volunteer's first time at the ReStore, they will have a brief orientation. After that a volunteer will meet the staff they will be working with, and receive a task. Tasks in the ReStore can vary a lot! We like to say there is something for everyone to do. If a volunteer feels uncomfortable with a task, they just need to let our staff know and there may be another option made just for them.

In the ReStore volunteers may be asked to:

accept donations ● merchandise the sales floor ● assist customers ● sort donations Organize departments ● light housekeeping ● price donations ●

Covid-19 Precautionary Measures:

All volunteers are asked to bring a face covering to site. A face covering must be worn by all volunteers, employees and customers. Temperatures will be taken every day. If a temperature is over 100 degrees the volunteer will be asked to go home. The staff is cleaning and disinfecting common surfaces multiple times a day. Most importantly, if you have symptoms of Covid-19 or have been exposed, do not report for you volunteer shift.

Pre-Approval: All ReStore volunteers need to be preapproved for their volunteer day by our ReStore Volunteer Coordinator. This needs to be completed before a volunteer's first day.

Basic ReStore Schedule: Our ReStore has volunteers hours available Tuesday through Saturday, from 8:00 - 4:00. We ask all first time volunteers to start their day at 8:30, when we hold an orientation.

After a volunteer's first day, they can come volunteer at any time we are open. We simply ask that all volunteers stay for at least three hours.



Upon Arrival: Please sign in on the tablet located in the front of the store. Volunteers 14-17 years old must have a waiver signed by a parent or guardian.

Safety: Safety is our top priority. Volunteers are required to use all safety equipment provided and to report any injury to a ReStore employee.

What to bring: Please bring a bag lunch and/or snacks. We have a break room with a refrigerator. Water is provided, but please bring a reusable bottle to help cut down on waste.

What to wear: Volunteers must wear sturdy closed toed shoes, no sandals, flip flops, open backs or flats will be permitted. Shorts may be worn but must reach finger tip length with arms at rest on the side of the body. No tank tops are allowed. All under garments must be covered by clothing, no spandex, or see through leggings are permitted. Volunteers must wear a nametag and vest daily which Habitat STW will provide.
