In addition to providing leadership and guidance, you will evaluate and maintain work site safety, and address any issues that arise during construction. By implementing quality control measures and enforcing regulatory compliance, you will contribute to the successful and timely completion of projects while fostering positive relationships with the local community.

<u>Work Environment:</u> The work environment for a Lead Site Supervisor at HFHSTW is primarily on construction sites, which can vary in conditions and locations.
